Broadening the path to affordable energy: the need for a more inclusive approach

As the European Commission presents the Clean Industrial Deal and the Action Plan for Affordable Energy, EUTurbines highlights the need for a more inclusive approach to affordable energy for Europe.

"We fully support the ambition to reduce European energy costs and support technologies that help achieving this but urge the Commission not to unduly narrow down the options that contribute to this goal," said Ralf Wezel, Secretary General of EUTurbines. "The most affordable pathway to a competitive European industry and energy system decarbonisation is based on a really integrated energy system. This includes hydrogen, CO2 and heat grids, and also turbomachinery-based cleantech solutions."

EUTurbines also calls for a state aid framework that allows Member States to support the provision of flexibility and generation capacities in their electricity grid in a technology-neutral non-discriminatory way, ensuring a reliable energy supply.
